- WHEN:** **Artwork Drop-Off (at the Clubhouse):** Tuesday, February 20 from 1:30 to 4:30 p.m., or Wednesday, February 21 from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. NOTE: Parking is available directly behind the Naperville Woman's Club Clubhouse via Central Park Place, which is one-way street south off of Benton Street. Entries must have the STUDENT INFORMATION ON THE BACK OF ART PIECE (student's name, high school, grade and brief description or title of piece).
- School Pick-Up/Drop-Off:** Teachers can arrange for entries to be picked-up at their school on Tuesday afternoon or Wednesday morning, February 20 or 21. A drop-off on Mon., Feb. 26 can also be pre-arranged (whereby NWC drops off the entries at the high school). - Judging:** Thursday, February 22 after 5 p.m.
- Public Reception:** Friday, February 23 from 5 to 7 p.m.
- ARTWORK:** **Category I:** Original two-dimensional artwork in pencil, pen & ink, collage, mixed media, paint, and pastel. *Original works only (no copies or reproductions of the original work).*  
**Category II:** Computer art and photography.  
**Category III:** Three-dimensional artwork, such as sculpture, pottery, and jewelry.
- VERY IMPORTANT:** **There is a limit of 3 entries per category per student.** Entries must have the STUDENT INFORMATION ON THE BACK OF ART PIECE (student's name, high school, grade and brief description or title of piece). **Teachers:** We would greatly appreciate if you would include a separate list of your students' entries providing name of student, grade, title and brief description or title of the piece, if submitting a large group.
- JUDGING:** Entries are judged on the following criteria: Technique, Concept, and Composition.
- RECEPTION:** Open to the Public on Friday, February 23 from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Clubhouse of the Naperville Woman's Club. Awards will be presented at 6 p.m. Students are encouraged to invite families, teachers, and friends to attend. Scholarship applications for one recipient to receive a summer art camp/course will be available. Read more below.
